



Traditional street/ farmers markets in Paris

There are 71 farmers street/ open-air markets in Paris and 11 markets in buildings called “covered” markets.

This tradition is long in France and the city authorities of Paris are engaged in various campaigns promoting shopping in these markets which are advertised as the places where fresh and good quality products are sold. For example, the city authorities organize annual green market festivals (2012 in May) with many attractive events at many markets. The city inhabitants enjoy, apart from good products they purchase there, also an opportunity of meeting neighbors from the local community. Additionally, each year from March till October, anybody can participate in cooking competitions under the auspices of the French Federation of Amateur Chefs.

There is at least one farmer's market in each of the Parisian arrondissements (districts). Below is the list of all of them, by arrondissement, from the 1st to the 20th district, with their location and hours of operation.

They vary in size and quality, some specialize in organic foods (Marché Brancusi 14th arr., Marché Raspail 6th arr., Marché des Batignolles 17th arr.) while others offer a variety of cooked foods (Marché Baudoyer 4th arr.) and/or ethnic dishes (Marché des Enfants Rouges 3rd arr.).

Profiles of selected Farmers Markets:

Marché Saint-Quentin

The market is one of very few remaining covered markets in Paris, which is a very interesting place to anyone who wants to take a closer look at the French architect Rabourdin's work or to anyone who wants to find out what you can experience behind the market's cast-iron doors.

St. Quentin is an impressive place with lots of space for vendors, and is very busy especially during weekends.

The local produce is not a strong point of St. Quentin as there are many imported products mainly from Spain. The Marché St. Quentin is in fact a hub of international food sellers, which makes it a specialist place in niche items you might not find at other smaller, open-air markets. While there, you can walk by African food stands, Italian delis, North African *epiceries*. There are also vendors selling region-specific French goods, like beer from the North of France. The choice of cheese from all over the country is also very tempting.

There is also an interesting beer boutique that sold unique beers. There you can find both Gallia and Demory, two brands of Parisian beer that have been made popular by young entrepreneurs.

If you feel like drinking your beer *sur place* the Marché St. Quentin has a friendly looking bistro where you take a break from shopping. Whatever you do, take advantage of the fact that, with so few covered markets left in Paris, you've found a spot where Rabourdin's ceiling and the entire building will keep you safe from the weather conditions, making St. Quentin a cosy place to visit in any season.



Marché Convention

Well-known for high quality of the products

This market seems to introduce a piece of French provincial life into the heart of Paris. Fresh fruits and vegetables, fishermen screaming at passersby to stop “if you ever want to eat well again”, gesticulating wildly to punctuate their sales offers. Inexplicably, grumpy cheese vendors (can too much cheese make you grumpy?) and very friendly butchers.



In France, many food stalls, the typical vendors behavior, hand-painted signs next to cosmopolitan boulevard in Paris all contribute to the market culture slowly fading in our modern world.

Marché Bastille

This is an big market with four isles that extend several blocks from the Bastille. Bras to beefsteak and everything in between. A very active and exciting place to visit with its bread to munch on, apples crisp and fresh, wine to bring home, and lots of other great products like truffles in small boxes, and... many local people shopping there giving it lots of personality.

Marché Boulevard Raspail

A very interesting market because it is fully organic.

It is the city's major *marché biologique* (as the French say), or an organic market, bursting with produce, fish, and eco-friendly products every Sunday. The market is also open on Tuesday and Friday with non-organic products.

Marché Treilhard (Covered Market)

A very small market, well-known for being open on Mondays.

Formerly known as the Europe market, the Treilhard covered market went back to its original name in 2009 to avoid any confusing with the "Europe" area in Paris.

The local market located near other shops boosts the life of the area around Miromesnil which is mainly an office area.

There is also a small supermarket there and some other service points.
